

EVICTION

There are only **8 reasons why a resident may be evicted** from a manufactured home park. Eviction is appropriate if:

- 1. A resident is late paying rent or utility charges owed to the park.
- 2. A resident fails to comply with a law or government rule relating to manufactured home parks.
- 3. A resident breaks the terms of the lease or the park's rules.
- 4. A resident repeatedly breaks important terms of the lease or park rules, or repeatedly breaks laws or government rules relating to manufactured home parks.
- 5. A resident does something in the park that endangers other residents or park personnel, substantially damages park property, or substantially annoys other residents.
- 6. All or part of the park is going to close.
- 7. The park owner is making improvements to the park that will substantially benefit the health and safety of the residents and it is necessary to remove a resident's home to complete the work.
- 8. A resident gives false information in the lease application.
